Tygart Lake Trail Descriptions

Dogwood Trail – The trail begins opposite Dam Trail near the Lodge passing through the forest with numerous dogwood trees. Trail climbs to a higher elevation above the lodge following a ridge top and descending back on the park road from the dam. 2 miles. Walking time 50-70 minutes.

Lake Trail – This trail begins at Picnic Area Number 3 and follows a small stream to the lake. The trail has few hills and is approximately ½ mile long. Walking time is 30 – 40 minutes.

Ridge Trail – This trail begins near the park office and ends at Picnic Area number 1. The trail passes through several forest types and is a good place to see wildlife. The trail is approximately ¾ mile long and has some steep hills. Walking time is 30-40 minutes.

Woodland Trail – Beginning near the park office, this trail passes through what was once a farm before ending between Cabin 5 and the campground. The trail has hills and is approximately 1 ½ miles long. Walking time is 30 minutes.

Tygart Dam Trail – This trail begins near the lodge and follows near the lakeshore before ending at the dam. This trail has few hills and is approximately ¾ mile long. Walking time is 30 minutes.
