ORDER EMERGENCY AREA FIRE CLOSURE FLORIDA FIRE CORONADO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and 36 CFR § 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited within National Forest Systems Lands affected by the Florida Fire, Nogales Ranger District, Coronado National Forest, in the State of Arizona. The specific restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

Going into or being upon the restricted area. 36 CFR § 261.52(e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

- Persons with a permit that authorizes actions specifically prohibited by this
 closure order.
- Any Federal, State or Local Officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 3. Forest Service employees in performance of an official duty.
- 4. Persons within the boundary of the Madera Canyon Recreation Area.

This order becomes effective at 8:00 a.m. July 25, 2005, and will remain in force until rescinded.
